Literacy is taught daily and contextualised using the concept and chosen topic wherever possible.

Numeracy is taught discretely every day, but contextualised, where possible, using the concept and chosen topic.

A mastery approach is deployed throughout both subjects.

Music and PE

Music is taught weekly using the concept and topic as a stimulus and context for learning wherever possible. Specialist teachers are often used to teach this subject.

'BIG PE' sessions are held weekly. A full 2-hour afternoon session is dedicated to indoor and outdoor PE, physical development and outdoor adventure.

Phonics & SPAG

A 20 minute phonics/SPAG session is delivered daily to all children. Children are streamed across phonics phases or SPAG groups and taught using the LCP scheme of work which is enhanced through the use of Jolly Phonics.
