Learning Objectives (from Skills Progression):

Computation/Number

Compares two groups of objects, saying when they have the same number. Shows an interest in number problems.

5

Says the number that is one more than a given number.

Finds one more or one less from a group of up to five objects, then ten objects Records, using marks that they can interpret and explain.

Children count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number
