<u>Thursday 6th March – World Book Day</u>

On Thursday it is World Book Day!



This day is all about celebrating and promoting the importance of reading. Did you know that:

- Reading enjoyment has been reported as more important for children's educational success than their family's socio-economic status (OECD, 2002).
- Evidence suggests that reading for pleasure is an activity that has positive emotional and social consequences (Clark and Rumbold, 2006).

During the day children will be joining in with lots of activities linked to reading, including live author workshops. We have even organised for buddy reading to take place across both schools; children in year 2 will visit nursery to read with our youngest pupils and children in year 6 will be coming to read with our pupils in Foundation Stage 2 and year 1. On this day we are inviting children to come to school dressed as a character from a story or wearing their pyjamas (no onesies please!). Please make sure your child's outfit and shoes still

enable them to play outside.

Don't forget to take part in our Where's Wally World Book Day competition by sharing your photos on Tapestry. Wally will also be hiding around school on the day for children to find! Children will also be bringing home their World Book Day £1 voucher, which can be exchanged for a special World Book Day book at local supermarkets, or used to discount the cost of a book.

Easter bonnet parade

Our annual Easter bonnet parade for children in Foundation Stage 2 and KS1 will take place on Wednesday 16th April at 2:45pm. Weather permitting, children will parade around the field/ yard wearing their bonnets and families are invited to come to watch. Should the weather not be kind to us, then the event will be cancelled as we do not have enough space inside to hold the event, however, children will still be able to share their bonnets with their friends during the day. Our nursery Easter bonnet parade will take place in nursery on Tuesday 15th April at 11am and 2:30pm.

<u> Junior School Easter bonnet parade – Thursday 17th April</u>

If you want to go to the Junior School to watch their Easter bonnet parade on Thursday 17th April at 2:45pm, then you are able to collect your nursery/ infant child early should you wish to. We will be allowing families to collect their children early for this reason, from 2:15pm. Nearer the time, we will ask you to indicate if you are planning on collecting your child early via a text form. Please note, early collection is only for those wanting to also go to watch the event at the Junior school. Nursery and school will finish at their normal times for all other children.

Our year 2 art gallery on this day will start from 2pm (as opposed to 2:30pm) to enable those families that also want to go to the Junior school come to see the art gallery before they go to the Junior school. This change of time is for all year 2 families. The art gallery will continue to run until the end of the day should you wish to come to it at 2:30pm as originally planned.

Outstanding balances

We kindly ask that any outstanding balances on your ParentPay account are settled at the end of every month.

If balances are not reduced over the 10 working days after the end of the month your child's participation in the payment event may be withdrawn, e.g. your child's place at a club may be withdrawn or you will be asked to send in a packed lunch rather than purchasing a school lunch. If you use childcare vouchers to pay we understand that there may be a delay in reducing the debts on your account, however please ensure payments are made regularly to keep your account up to date.

If you are having difficulties clearing any outstanding balances or have any queries regarding your account please contact the school office who will be able to provide help and support where needed.

Easter Food vouchers

As part of the Household Support Fund, Sheffield council is planning to provide a £30 food supplement voucher for 34,000 children and young people across the city for the Easter holidays to assist families with rising costs.
