Welcome back

When we introduced PE kits at the start of this academic year we asked that children had the correct school PE kit by Easter. This was to give families enough time to organise for this change. As a reminder, the PE kit we will expect to see in school from Easter will need to consist of:

- Black or navy shorts or jogging bottoms
- White T Shirt (with or without the logo)
- Black, navy or royal blue jumper (optional) (with or without the logo)
- Trainers or pumps

Don't forget that PE days have changed for children in year 1 and year 2 this half term (please see below for reminders of these changes).

Arriving late to nursery - reminder

In nursery, our registers are taken at the start of each session before children start their learning activities. After 30 minutes of a session starting, registers will be closed. If you arrive after this time then you will need to come to the school office once you have dropped your child off at nursery so they can be marked as present.

Attendance - reminder

Good attendance and punctuality at school is important. Our attendance target this year is 95%. If your child's attendance so far this year has been at or above this target, they will be receiving an attendance certificate to say well done! If your child's attendance has fallen below 90% then you will be receiving a letter to let you know about this and how school will be monitoring attendance and offering any support needed.
