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This week's updates...



We have had a great first full week back at school. In particular, it has been wonderful to welcome our new children in Reception and Nursery, and their families. Across school, children have been enjoying settling into new routines and taking part in new learning experiences.

Whilst everyone adjusts to routines, it may mean that you have to wait a little longer at the end of the day to collect your child whilst staff get used to new faces. Please bear with us – we will get faster! Also, should a new adult be collecting your child, please make sure they know the password so we can ensure they are sent home with the correct person.

Phonics and reading books

We follow the Letters and Sounds Little Wandle phonics programme. This programme ensures that all children receive daily phonics sessions, and children in Reception and KS1 receive three reading sessions per week. Once your child has read their phonetically decodable book in school three times this is then sent home for them to read with you. We like to say this is a chance for them to 'show off' their reading! Children will also bring home a 'love of reading' book, which they have chosen from their class book corner to share at home. Please fill in your child's reading record when you have read their phonetically decodable book, as well as shared their 'love of reading' book.

Children in Reception started their phonics lessons and reading sessions today. However, for the next few weeks, the reading sessions are story sharing sessions. Children in Reception will be bringing their first book to read at home in a few weeks' time – this is also when they will be given their new book bag (if they didn't attend our nursery).

Children can also sign up for a RockSteady lesson, which takes place in school on a Friday morning. This is open to all children from Reception to Year 2. Attached to this newsletter is a flyer containing more information about this.

Names in coats and lunchboxes

It is really important that children's names are in their coats and uniform, as well as lunch boxes. At lunch time, children very often take off their coats and forget to collect them when the bell goes. We will always return named items to their owner and anything unnamed will be placed in the lost property box in the main entrance.

ParentPay and Superkids after-school wrap-around care

All our new starters should have received their new ParentPay activation codes. It is important that you use this system as this will allow you to book and pay for after-school wraparound care, and pay for any additional events. If you need help using the platform, please speak with the school office.

For those using Superkids, sessions can now be viewed and booked (if places) up to October half term. Please remember that any changes to a session need to be made 48 hours before the session. After this, you will need to contact the office to make any changes. Any sessions which are not cancelled in advance and are not used will still be charged for, unless the child is ill.

Superkids is very busy and places are sought after, so please cancel sessions if you no longer need them.
