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This week's updates...

<u>Welcome</u>

This week we are thrilled to welcome our new starters joining us in Nursery and in Reception. We are looking to forward to getting to know each and every one of you and your families.

New routines

Thank you to everyone for remembering our new school times and arriving promptly in the morning to start. This has meant that our children are able to get settled and straight into their first lesson quickly.

For clarification, Reception and KS1 classroom doors open at 8:40am with the first lesson (phonics) starting promptly at 8:55am. Teachers will save registers at 8:55am. Anyone arriving after this time will need to come to the main office for registration and will be marked as late. Anyone arriving after 9:10am will receive an unauthorised absence mark for the morning session.

Nursery staff will open their doors at 8:30am. Once the doors are closed, you will need to ring the bell and wait for a staff member to open the door. At times you may have to wait a little bit for this as staff are busy looking after the children. Where possible, we ask that you arrive promptly and do not try to collect your child early to avoid disruption.

Reading books

This week, children in KS1 will start their phonics programme again. All children will receive daily phonics sessions and 3 reading sessions per week. This year all children will have their reading sessions between Monday and Wednesday. Reading books will be sent home each Wednesday and we ask that they are returned to school the following Wednesday, apart from children who are accessing the fluency programme, where books are changed fortnightly. We kindly ask that you look after your child's reading book and return it to us in good condition and on-time, so that other children can enjoy the book. Should you lose your child's book we ask that you contribute towards the cost of a new one.


Diary dates
