Anti-bullying Week

This week is anti-bullying week, where the theme of the week is 'Choose Respect': From playgrounds to parliament, our homes to our phones, this Anti-Bullying Week let's 'Choose Respect' and bring an end to bullying which negatively impacts millions of young lives.

This year, we'll empower children and young people to not resort to bullying, even when we disagree and remind adults to lead by example, online and offline.

Imagine a world where respect and kindness thrives — it's not just a dream, it's in the choices we make. Join us this Anti-Bullying Week and commit to 'Choose Respect'.

During the week children will take part in discussions and learning activities focusing on respect.

One way we started the week off by showing respect was taking part in a 2 minute silence at 11am today across school to mark Remembrance Day.

Christmas performances

Every year group will be taking part in a special Christmas performance. For fire regulations, our school hall/ nursery classroom has a limited capacity. Therefore, each child (or family if there are siblings in the same year group) has been allocated 3 tickets for their performances. Any toddler or baby attending the performance must be allocated a ticket. Families are able to use these tickets across multiple performances or for the same one. We will send out information later this week about how to book your tickets.
