This week's updates...



Free School Meals and Half term food vouchers

Did you know that you may be entitled to free school meals if you receive any of these benefits:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support
- income based Jobseeker's Allowance
- income related Employment Support Allowance
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit as long as you have a yearly household income of less than £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue and Customs) and do not get Working Tax Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

Applying for free school meals for your child means that they will be entitled to free school lunches once their free infant school lunch entitlement ends (after year 2). It also means that they qualify for free milk and families are entitled to holiday food vouchers which can be used in 11 different supermarkets to reduce food bills. School also receives additional funding for children entitled to free school meals which can help to improve our offer and provision.

As part of the Household Support Fund, Sheffield Council will be providing a £15 food supplement voucher for 35,000 children and young people across the city for the October half-term holidays to assist families with rising costs.

Vouchers will be issued via letter directly to families w/c 21st October. The letter will include the website link for Edenred (the supplier of vouchers) and clear instructions on how to download the voucher.

Any child/young person that becomes eligible between 7th October and 27th October 2024 will be sent a food voucher letter w/c 4th November 2024.

Year 1 and Year 2 Wellbeing afternoons

We are looking forward to seeing those parents who can join us for our year 1 and year 2 wellbeing afternoons this week, which we hope will promote positive mental health, introduce families to our Zones of Regulation work and give you an opportunity to come into school to spend time with your children. As a reminder:

- Year 2 on Tuesday 8th October 1.20pm 3pm
- Year 1 on Wednesday 9th October 1.20pm 3pm

During the first part of the afternoon you and your child will take part in a mindfulness craft activity in their classroom (which they will be able to take home) followed by the opportunity to see one of our carpet time discussions in action about our new Zones of Regulation.

We will then be taking parents/ carers up to the hall for hot drinks and biscuits (and there may be a little treat you can take home as well!) as the children tidy up and prepare for home time. We hope this gives you some time to talk to each other as fellow parents, as well as think about how the Zones of Regulation may be able to support your child outside of school.

Unfortunately due to the lack of space in our classrooms, we ask that only one adult attends the afternoon per child. For the same reason younger siblings and pushchairs will not be able to join us on this occasion.

Please do not worry if you are not able to attend, your children will still join in with the activities and will be supported by a grown up in school.

For the craft activity we would be grateful for any donations of small, clean drinks bottles.
